COVID-19 Updates Pertaining to Schools

In President Museveni's speech to the nation on June 6, 2021 regarding the resurgence of COVID-19 and the current status of the pandemic in Uganda, it was pointed out that those most affected in the current third wave are young people (20-39 year old) with growing transmission among 10-19 year olds. Part of the new directives from the president are that all schools are to close for 42 days from June 7, 2021. Also teachers are required to be fully vaccinated before returning to school. Please pray for the school children as well as the people of Uganda at this difficult time.

Why I Got Involved with F.A.C.E.

"In January of 1997, I had the privilege to travel to Rwanda with a humanitarian organization that was building housing and schools for returning refugees who had managed to escape the genocide. It was my first trip to Africa. The country, the people, and their lack of access to basic necessities, that we often take for granted, left a lasting impression on me. As a result, I began sponsoring various medical outreach, humanitarian, and child assistance programs. I have returned numerous times since then to participate in school building projects in Uganda, Kenya, Ghana, and Eswatini. Each trip made me very aware of the challenges and obstacles that many parents/guardians face in trying to obtain a basic education for their children - school fees, basic school supplies, lack of desks and blackboards, deteriorated mud-brick classrooms, or no classrooms at all.

Several years ago, I was introduced to F.A.C.E. and the work that they have been doing in Uganda. It was an easy decision to decide to become a monthly sponsor and give these children a chance for a better future."
