How COVID-19 Affects FACE

Thank you for your support to Free African Children thru Education. We greatly appreciate your faithfulness in providing for the schooling needs of Ugandan orphans. As with schools in various parts of the world, COVID-19 has had an impact on schools in Uganda and, according to the latest information from our Communications Assistant in Uganda, Robert Bawube, this school year is a loss, meaning that the children will not return to school this year. Uganda implemented a strict lock down which has kept the coronavirus numbers low, but at an economic cost. The country's response was apparently formed by its prior battles with infectious diseases like Ebola and was already on the alert because of an outbreak of Ebola in the Democratic Republic of Congo. Regarding 2020 funding, 50% was paid out during the first term. No further funds have been sent since the schools have been closed. Your donations have continued to come in and for this we are grateful. Despite the current school closure, we would like to ask for your continuing support as, according to our treasurer, Charlene, we have been short of sponsors for orphans already enrolled in the FACE program and have been using our reserve funds to meet our commitments.
