FACE is Now Helping School Children in Uganda and Eswatini

For those who joined us in March via Zoom for our Annual Meeting with donors, we informed you that FACE was working on exciting plans to expand the scope of our program, both within Uganda and beyond. We are now pleased to offer this update.

At FACE, we believe that a proper learning environment is also important to the education of a child. As such, the Board has voted that in addition to student sponsorship, we will now accept donations that enable us to provide assistance to our schools in Uganda to upgrade and maintain their facilities by providing blackboards, desks, benches, painting and repairs, as well as construction of new classroom buildings, as required.

These photos were taken at some of the schools that FACE supports in Uganda.

As you can see, blackboards are often in poor condition.



Some schools can't provide enough desks or benches for all the students.



Many classrooms are overcrowded. Others may just need a coat of paint, or minor repairs.



At this school, the round hut is the teacher's staff room. It provides some protection during the rainy season.

Students and teachers must also walk through the mud to get to their classrooms.

Wooden boardwalks or gravel pathways would help.



Some classrooms provide little protection from the elements.

A new classroom building would help to improve the learning environment, and possibly encourage more enrolment of children in school.



FACE has also finalized plans to begin working in the country of Eswatini (formerly known as Swaziland), and is now accepting donations to sponsor students at the Mahlanya SDA Primary School, located just outside the capital city of Mbabane.

We are also launching a fundraising campaign to begin a four-year project to construct new urgently needed classroom buildings.



The existing two-classroom building, constructed in 2019 for Grade's 0 and 1 students, is the only school in the area. As enrolment continues to grow, and these students graduate, more classrooms are needed. The cost to construct a two-classroom building is \$30,000 CDN, which includes the supply of blackboards and all desks and chairs. Each classroom can accommodate up to 40 students.
